SAND SPRINGS FY 2019 NEEDS PUBLIC HEARING**

A Public Hearing will be held at 7:00 p.m., Monday, March 23, 2020 in the Court Room at the Sand Springs Public Safety Facility, 602 W Morrow Rd, Sand Springs, OK 74063, to receive recommendations on community development needs for the City of Sand Springs, as a member of the Tulsa County CDBG Urban County. The City of Sand Springs is planning to submit an FY 2020 application to Tulsa County in the Metro Cities category. The City is anticipating on receiving an allocation in Tulsa County FY 2020 CDBG funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Citizens are requested to participate in the Public Hearing and express their views on community development needs and on the allocation of these funds within the City of Sand Springs.

Recommendations received will be considered by the Sand Springs City Council, the CDBG Urban County Policy Committee, and the INCOG staff in developing the Sand Springs Urban County CDBG Metro Cities application. Comments or proposals, where feasible, will be incorporated into the application to be submitted to Tulsa County by April 3, 2020.
